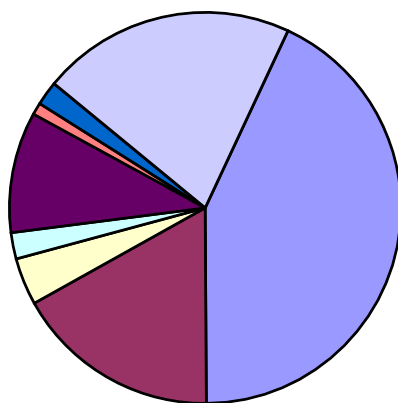

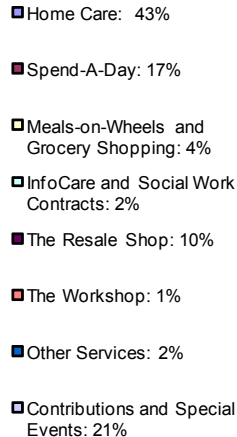

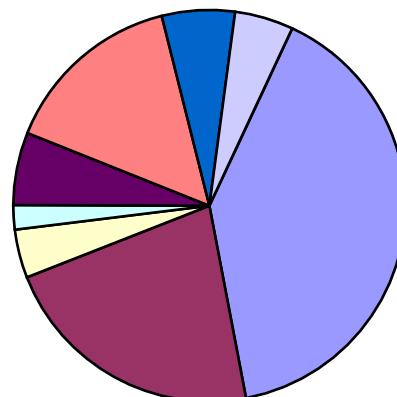
SAGE 2008 FINANCIALS



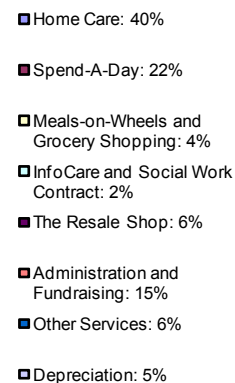
2008 Revenue *

As of December 31st, 2008, SAGE's Endowment Fund Balance was \$1,206,386 including \$389,837 in Cash and Cash Equivalents and \$816,549 in investment securities. The Endowment Fund is an investment fund, established to support the organization's ongoing expenditures, capital purchases or to fund specific projects and programs. The detailed financial information that is furnished to the Internal Revenue Service and the State of New Jersey is available for public inspection at our offices upon request.

SAGE SERVES AND SUPPORTS THE COMMUNITY FOR 55 YEARS

HOMECARE

The HomeCare Department provided care to **187** homebound seniors which included an estimated **630** home visits by the registered nursing staff.

Many of our home health aides have worked for SAGE between **20** and **30** years, with an average of **10** years experience in the field.

Generations of families have benefited from SAGE's **55** year-old HomeCare program. There are some local families who have received continued HomeCare services from SAGE for nearly **10** years.

The Home Health Aide you sent to care for our mother is a person who cares deeply about the physical and psychological health of her patient and patient's family. We cannot thank you enough for sending the most qualified, competent, caring and truly devoted person to attend to our mother's needs.

MEALS on WHEELS

Thanks to SAGE's Meals on Wheels program, **281** frail, homebound or disabled seniors received nutritious meals and reliable check-ins from our **600** person volunteer team.

Since 2007, meals delivered increased by **12.5%** and clients increased by **8%**.



Each weekday, **20** to **30** volunteers are scheduled to fill **14** routes and drive a total of **200** miles to deliver more than **230** meals to **150** clients in the **3** counties.

SAGE has a volunteer who has been delivering meals locally for **42** years, which is longer than anyone else in the United States.

SPEND-A-DAY

Spend-A-Day Adult Day Health Center provided a total of **8,785** days to all their clients who found a safe and welcoming home at the facility while their families and caregivers received a valuable respite.

Clients in Spend-A-Day exercised a total of **125** hours and walked a total of **450** miles on the indoor stroll path showing improved mobility and flexibility with both resulting in less falls.

A total of **3,540** birthday years were celebrated among Spend-A-Day clients.

GROCERY SHOPPING & ERRAND SERVICE



SAGE's Grocery Shopping & Errand service enabled **58** elderly or disabled individuals to receive **1,070** deliveries in 2008.

30 shopping volunteers navigated the aisles of **2** local supermarkets for **1,600** hours and bought **\$70,662** worth of groceries.

SMALL HOME REPAIR SERVICE & BILL PAYING SERVICE

These two part-time services raised **\$17,907** through **397** visits made to **165** older adults and their families with home repair and bill paying support.

INFOCARE

2,003 people of all ages benefited from the free information, referrals, home visits and support group meetings provided by the social workers through the InfoCare program.

8 trained SHIP (State Health Insurance Assistance Program) counselors volunteered **818** hours of their time, and helped complete **584** forms while offering free and confidential counseling for NJ Medicare beneficiaries with health insurance questions to **2,116** seniors.

P.R.E.P. (People Responsible for Elderly Persons) hosted **240** caregivers and their families during free monthly support meetings. Infinite problems and solutions were shared amidst countless tears and much laughter.

ELDERCARE PLANNING AND GUIDANCE

Introduced in late 2008, Eldercare Planning and Guidance reached the areas most vulnerable and isolated seniors. **38** seniors received personalized extended care planning through the program, and **75** benefited from initial consultations.

The social workers in the Eldercare Planning and Guidance program spent nearly **1,000** hours assisting elderly clients and their caregivers with guidance and referrals to programs, services and care coordination based on a personal plan for each individual.

The Eldercare Planning and Guidance program began solely through generous gifts from SAGE's Community Partners. This program is fully funded through the support of grants from **5** funders. They include the Grotta Fund for Senior Care of the Jewish Community Foundation of Metrowest N.J., the Blanche M. and George L. Watts Mountainside Community Foundation, the Summit Area Public Foundation, the Fred C. Rummel Foundation, the Arnold A. Schwartz Foundation and the Westfield Foundation.

EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS

760 older adults reduced their risk of falling through the Fall Prevention Initiative.

25 older adults improved their strength, agility, balance and endurance over the course of **92** weekly classes as part of the Fall Prevention Initiative.

260 people improved their knowledge of brain health, talking to their aging parents, memory, strokes, hearing and much more through **16** free educational programs offered throughout the year.

FURNITURE RESTORATION WORKSHOP

20 Furniture Restoration Workshop volunteers gave freely of their time and talents to help raise **\$40,000** through their daily volunteer work in the **4,500** sq. ft. workshop.

320 local area residents are sitting pretty on the **230** chairs that were caned and/or rushed in the Furniture Restoration Workshop, totaling about **9,000** hours of volunteer time by the craftspeople.



THE RESALE SHOP

The Resale Shop brings in **\$313,936.97** which contributes to the sustainability of SAGE and our programs.



DEVELOPMENT

Nearly **1,400** donations to SAGE from individuals, corporations, private and public foundations, special events and the local United Ways helped SAGE continue to serve thousands of seniors, their families and caregivers throughout the year that enabled them to maintain their independence by staying in their homes.
